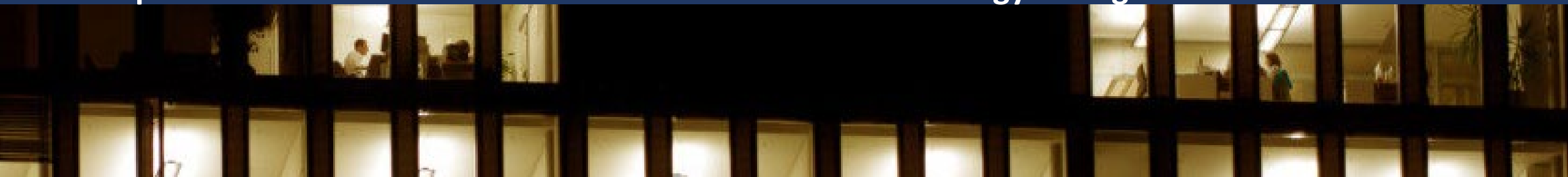
Vision Statement

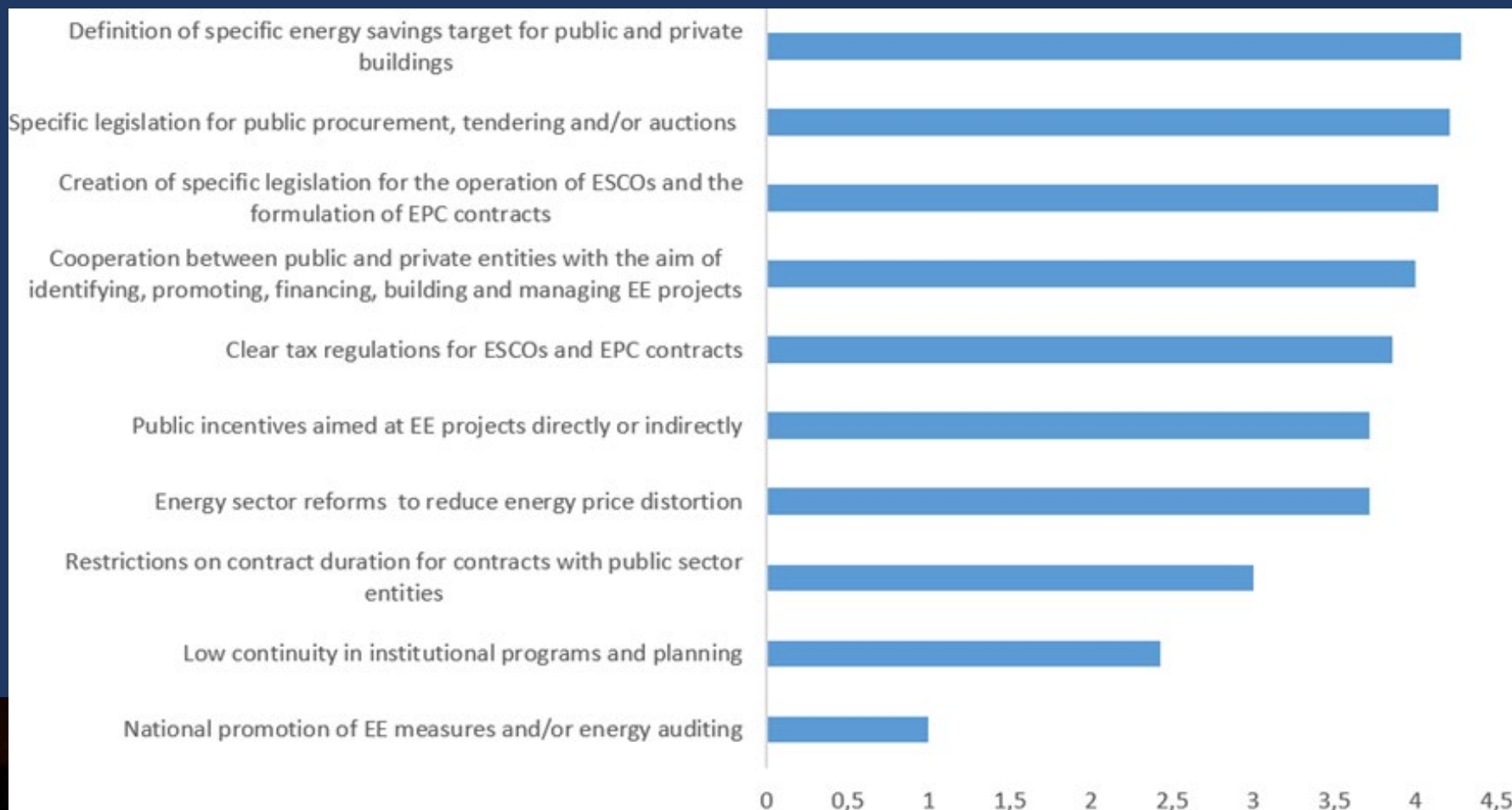
To be the global driver
